Zoom, Centres Square Thru 3,... Swing Corner and Promenade Just take what you need from the ladies, then leave them, With the words of a sad country song.

Middle Break Circle left I learned of all the rules of the modern-day drifter, Don't hold on to nothin' too long. Men Star By The Right, roll it once around now. Allemande Left and Weave the ring.
