Circle left (1st) Hey, I wanta do a little rockin' (2nd) Yeah, I feel a little rowdy myself (1st) See if you can sing the high parts, brother (2nd) I can if you give me some help Walk around that corner lady See saw round your own Allemande left that corner Gonna weave the ring (1st) We've been down a whole lotta alleys (2nd) And shook a whole lotta cans Swing and whirl that pretty little girl, promenade that ring (1st) Here we are smack dab in the middle (2nd) But I think we can adjust (Both) We ain't half bad for two old cats like us

FIGURE (twice heads - twice sides) Heads (sides) promenade halfway round that ring Down the middle square thru four hands around I sing Four hands around and then dosado Swing thru two by two, boys you run Half tag, trade & roll, pass thru, trade by Swing that lady go round & round, promenade that ring (1st) *We can take it to the limit (2nd) *Or take it to the bus (Both) We ain't half bad for two old cats like us
