TURN YOUR PARTNER BY THE RIGHT

LEFT ALLEMANDE the corner girl – then PROMENADE And then I go & spoil it all by saying something stupid Like, I love you

FIGURE:

HEADS go RIGHT & LEFT THRU, ROLL-AWAY And then PASS THRU, BOTH TURN RIGHT SINGLE FILE SIDES PASS THRU, make a RIGHT HAND STAR One time around awhile, HEAD MEN LEAD OUT

EVERYBODY JOIN HANDS, CIRCLE TO THE LEFT - - - CORNER SWING, then PROMENADE

And then I go & spoil it all by saying something stupid Like, I love you

SIX COUPLE SET – use 9 x 64 instrumental

INTRODUCTION, BREAK & CLOSER:

Join up your hands CIRCLE TO THE LEFT

I know I stand in line until you think you'll have the time To spend an evening with me SIX MEN STAR RIGHT one time around PASS THE PARTNER BY – ALLEMANDE LEFT

- - - SWING YOUR LADY PROMENADE HER HOME

And then I go & spoil it all by saying something stupid Like, I love you

FIGURE 1:

HEADS COUPLES LEAD TO THE RIGHT

ALL THE GIRLS ON THE DIAGONAL PASS THRU EVERYBODY SINGLE FILE CIRCULATE, BOYS RUN - - SLIDE THRU, EVERYBODY LEAD TO THE RIGHT - - - TRADE BY,

SWING THRU and then, TURN THRU LEFT ALLEMANDE, come back and PROMENADE And then I go & spoil it all by saying something stupid Like, I love you

FIGURE 2:

HEAD COUPLES PASS THE OCEAN, LADIES TRADE EXTEND, ALL TWELVE CIRCULATE - - SWING THRU, BOYS RUN To the right, BEND THE LINE, TOUCH 1/4 now

SINGLE FILE CIRCULATE, **BOY RUN** to the right **CORNER SWING**, and **PROMENADE** And then I go & spoil it all by saying something stupid Like, I love you

NOTE: Brian calls additional choreo on the vocal track for the Breaks, and Figures.

SIX COUPLE SETS

Six regular couples are arranged with four Head couples (as facing lines), and two Side couples, as they would be in a normal square.

If you intend calling to individual dancers (or "Odds & Evens"), the numbering of couples is started with the left hand Head couple having their backs to the Caller, then continued in a counter clockwise direction (as in a regular set). # 2 is to the right of #1, #3 is a Side couple, #4 is a Head, facing #2, #5 is a Head, facing #1, and #6 is the other Side couple. Odd couples are #1, #3 & #5, while evens are #2, #4 & #6.

You can use almost all of the Mainstream & Plus calls with this formation. However, there are a few basics which need minor modifications. Grand R & L for example requires an extra 2 hands. AND the great news for Callers is that the majority of your Singing Call routines will work with a Six-Couple-Set (some won't). You do however need to allow an extra 8 beats for a full Promenade.

These sets provide excellent variety for your Dancers, and are very useful when you only have 6 couples, or if you have two sets, and some Dancers want to take a break. You don't need to teach anything new to get them started!

One of the instrumental tracks on this CD has been edited to run 9 times through. This will allow you to call an "Intro", "Break" & "Closer", and 6 "Figures". I have also provided a Mainstream vocal on the CD for a Six-Couple-Set.

<u>"LEAD TO THE RIGHT" (from normal Lines of 4 or 6)</u>: Couples move forward in a 90 degree arc (Boys passing Left shoulders) to end facing to their Right. The ending formation will have couples back-to-back with the couple they had been facing when in the line.
