FIGURE:

HEADS/SIDES BOX THE GNAT – SQUARE THRU 2

CENTERS IN – CAST OFF 3/4 'ROUND

CENTERS WHEEL AROUND – EVERYBODY WHEEL AROUND

STAR THRU AND DIVE THRU AND SQUARE THRU GO 3

THREE QUARTER 'ROUND LEFT HAND BOX THE GNAT

YOU COURTESY TURN AND PROMENADE GO WALKING ALL AROUND LIKE THAT
YOU THINK THAT I COULD MUSTER UP A LITTLE SOFT SHOE GENTLE SWAY
BUT I DON'T FEEL LIKE DANCIN' NO SIR, NO DANCIN' TODAY.

BREAK / CLOSER

SIDES FACE GRAND SQUARE:
