(Sides Face, Grand Square)

### **Figure - twice for Heads, twice for Sides**

(Let's see the) Heads you promenade halfway  
Lead to the right, circle four, you make a line  
Whoop to the middle and come on back  
Right & left thru, well you turn 'em you know  
Flutterwheel round you go, sweep one quarter more  
Pass thru, corner swing, promenade don't you know  
There's always a smile to remind me that you were here

### **Alternative Words for Middle break**

(Sides Face, Grand Square)  
Now there's a smile, to cheer me up when I'm lonely  
That I can call whenever I'm feeling down (allemande left, weave the ring)  
Smile and you know that I'm only  
Longing for the minute you'll be around

### **Alternative Words for Closer**

(Sides Face, Grand Square)  
Help me, 'cause I'm trying to get over  
The way I thought of love many times before (allemande left, weave the ring)  
If ever you should go away and never again would be near  
There's always a smile to remind me that you were here
