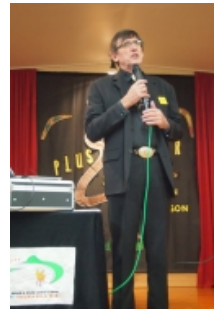




San Antonio Stroll

FIGURE

1/2 Tag, Swing, Promenade
I'd fall asleep in my chair, and dream that I was right there
Dancing the whole night (through)

MIDDLE BREAK

Circle Left
My folks would come home, they'd be humming a tune
and saying child don't you know
Left Allemande, Turn Partner by the Right
Left Allemande, Weave the Ring
Then the lights went down low, the fiddler picked up his bow
Swing that girl, Promenade
There ain't a thing in this world
To make you fall in love, Boy, like a San Antonio Stroll

Circle Left
