OPENER Circle left A long time ago in 1944 When every Mother's son was going off to war Walk around that corner lady, seesaw your taw Left allemande and weave that hall Well, now you jump, shout, knock yourself out You swing your honey, promenade back home If you get the heebie-geebies you can dance them away To the boogie woogie beat that piano man played

FIGURE

Heads (sides) flutter wheel Sides promenade 1/4 A double pass thru, a cloverleaf And now the centers star thru, you back away 4 ladies chain 3/4 around I say And now the sides face, grand square 8 steps You swing your corner lady, you promenade If you pull a switch-a-roony you could feel low down To the boogie woogie beat that piano man played

MIDDLE BREAK

Circle left

Don't you think we should get our spirits up high For Uncle Sam and Mother's good ole apple pie Walk around that corner lady, seesaw your taw Left allemande and weave that hall Well, now you jump, shout, knock yourself out You swing your honey, promenade back home If you get the heebie-geebies you can dance them away To the boogie woogie beat that piano man played

CLOSER

Circle left

It has a kind of rhythm that will fit the hall It will make the man up front think it drives you up a wall Walk around that corner lady, seesaw your taw Left allemande and weave that hall Well, now you jump, shout, knock yourself out You swing your honey, promenade back home If you get the heebie-geebies you can dance them away To the boogie woogie beat that piano man played

TAG

Swing her now I said that boogie woogie beat is what I'm talking about
