INTRODUCTION, BREAK & CLOSER: (Check Brian's vocal for additional lyrics)

SIDES FACE, GRAND SLIDE (or GRAND SQUARE)

IT'S EARLY SUNDAY MORNING, AND THE SUN IS COMING UP
I'M HEADED FOR THE GOLF COURSE, I'M GONNA TRY MY LUCK
STRAIGHTEN THAT LEFT ELBOW, SLIGHTLY BEND YOUR KNEES
HEAD ABOVE THE BALL, AND LOOK OUT FOR THE TREES

FOUR LADIES PROMENADE INSIDE, GO ONCE AROUND THE RING
SWING WITH YOUR MAN, AND YOU PROMENADE AGAIN
HELP ME KEEP MY HEAD DOWN, SAVE ME FROM THE DOUBLE BOGIE
BLUES

FIGURE:

(WHY NOW THE) **HEADS PROMENADE, YOU GO HALF-WAY ROUND THE FLOOR**
WALK IN AND SQUARE THRU, AND SOMEONE HOLLERED "FOUR"
HEY WHEN YOU DO, **SWING THRU** WITH THAT PAIR
BOY RUN RIGHT, AND THEN A **FERRIS WHEEL** FROM THERE

SQUARE THRU, GO 3/4 'ROUND RING
SWING YOUR CORNER LADY, PROMENADE 'EM AGAIN
HELP ME KEEP MY HEAD DOWN, SAVE ME FROM THE DOUBLE BOGIE
BLUES

EXPLANATION of GRAND SLIDE:

This is a very easy, 32 beat "Grand" figure, that has the same "Traffic Pattern" as GRAND SQUARE. It was introduced during the late 1960's as a demonstration at a United States National. Although not frequently called now in the U.S., in Australia it has become a standard figure, and is recognised there as part of the BASIC Program.

From a normal "Squared Set", Side Couples "Face". Then for the next 32 beats nobody turns. Dancers will walk FORWARD, and BACKWARDS (in FOUR STEPS), and they'll move sideways in TWO SLIDING STEPS.

1st 4 beats: Sides Walk Backwards, Heads Walk Forward – Four Steps (as in Grand Square).

2nd 4 beats: ALL the Men Slide to their Left, Ladies Slide to their Right – Side, Close, Side, Close.

3rd 4 beats: Original Sides now Walk Forward, Original Heads Walk Backwards Four Steps.

4th 4 beats: ALL the Men Slide to their Right, Ladies Slide to their Left – Side, Close, Side, Close.

The whole action is now REVERSED: Starting with all the Men Sliding to their Left, and the Ladies Sliding to their Right.
