FIGURE

(Heads/Sides) Pass the Ocean, Extend to the outside two Girls trade, recycle round you do Pass thru, trade by, touch one quarter then Scootback and then the boys you fold behind the girls Girls sway sway sway to the ten guitars Turn around, you swing and you promenade so far **Through the eyes of love you see a thousand stars When you dance, dance, dance, to my ten guitars**
