## FIGURE:

The Heads/Sides Square Thru four hands and go

Dosado to an Ocean Wave

Spin The Top, move up girls, the Boys Run Right

Wheel & Deal to a line of four A Right & Left Thru

Square Thru  $\frac{3}{4}$  round that way

Swing that corner and Promenade

## BREAK & CLOSER:

Circle Left

You know I had me a lover and I tried, tried, tried

Finally had to leave her and she cried, cried, cried

The Men Star Right and roll it one time around you go

Left Allemande and Weave

I wonder what my heart would say Swing and Promenade
