Figure:

Heads (Sides) square thru 4,  
Dosaso,  
Touch  $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
Split circulate,  
Hinge, and girls trade,  
Swing thru,  
Swing thru again,  
Swing and promenade.  
\*I laugh and smile to please the kids, whenever they're around,  
Where is the circus, here is the clown.  
\*I know my heart will break, the day you bring the curtain down,  
Where is the circus, here comes the clown.

Additional lyrics:

Break:
