Opener

Circle left:

Well I was born on a Friday in the Florida sun, By the Kissimmee River before I was one,
Men star right and turn it one time around, Left allemande & weave that ring,
My mama alligator said to me with a smile,
Swing with your and promenade for a while,
Take a little bit of country, some slow rock & roll, and what cha got going is the alligator stroll.

Figure

The heads you promenade you travel half way around,
Walk in go right & thru with an arm around,
Well you square thru 4 hands and then, go right & left thru & turn the girl my friend,
A 1/2 sashay, you box the gnat, that corner swing,
Keep my baby then you all promenade.
Little bit of country, some slow rock & roll, and what cha got going is the alligator stroll.

Break

Circle left:

I hold my head up high, I keep my feet on the ground, I never hurry as I'm strolling around.
Men star right and turn it one time around, Left allemande & weave that ring,
I keep a certain tempo that's lazy and sweet,
Swing with your and promenade for a while,
Take a little bit of country, some slow rock & roll, and what cha got going is the alligator stroll.

Closer

Circle left,

I don't want to fight, I don't want to bite, I use my 75 teethe for a smile so bright,
Men star right and turn it one time around, Left allemande & weave that ring,
You can recognize me by my rose colored shades,
As I make my way through the everglades
I'm strolling, oh bless my soul, and what we got going is the alligator stroll.

Tag

Back out circle left, here we go now, a little bit of left, right, left, It's called the alligator stroll.
